Please complete paperwork & bring to your child's appointment. It can also be returned prior to their appointment via fax 419-756-7456. Some forms do require the signature of a witness, which can be anyone over 18.

The legal guardian **must** accompany the child to the appointment. If applicable, bring any relevant custody paperwork. If you have shared parenting, **both** parents must complete financial paperwork.

Please bring: (if applicable)

- Insurance card(s)
- Driver's License, State ID or another form of identification. See "Acceptable forms of ID"
- Richland County Residents Only To see if you qualify for financial assistance from the Richland County Mental Health Board you will need to bring proof of family income. Proof of no income may include a discharge letter from your previous employer, an unemployment letter or your earnings statement from the Social Security Office.

If you live in Richland County, Assessments are covered at 100% regardless of your insurance & income. All other services are covered based on your insurance benefits and income.
