





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# FISCAL YEAR 2025 UPDATES

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# FISCAL YEAR 2025 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

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
This fiscal year was July 2024 through June 2025. September of 2024 brought our 3rd Annual Recovery Event to celebrate Recovery Month. This was quickly followed by our national accreditation survey from CARE, the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities. We received another three-year accreditation.

Multiple grants allowed us to make updates to our buildings, including adult medical as described above, but also the vocational offices at Progress Industries in the Rehab building. This included new flooring, ceiling tiles, updated lighting, and new paint.

March of 2025 brought the 46th annual News Journal All Star Game. This was the first game that included the girls team playing the same night as the boys, and the second All Star Game for the girls. The funds raised at the game help support the annual Kid's Carnival in May.
